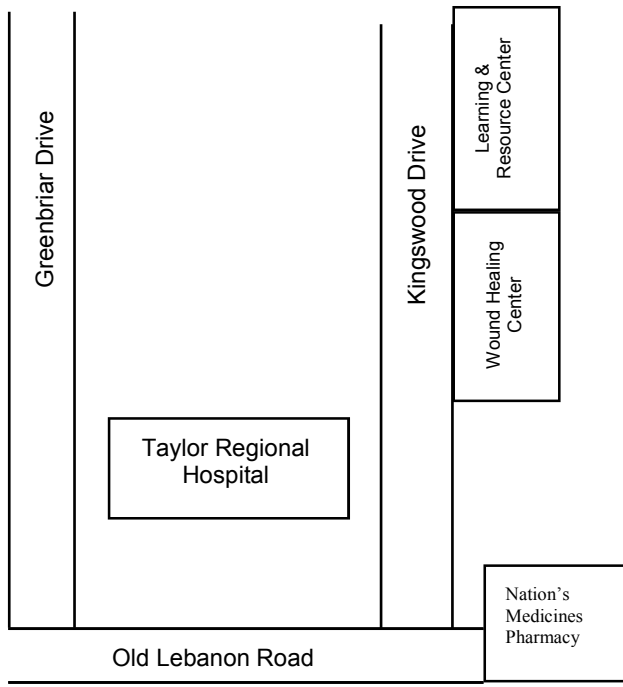

- Antibiotics
- Specialty dressings
- Education on prevention and treatment of wounds & diseases
- Biopsies
- Tissue cultures
